Please keep in mind, the Coordinated Entry System (CES) helps prioritize limited housing resources in Chicago and helps us advocate for more. There is not a housing option available for every eligible person who completes a Coordinated Entry Housing Assessment.

Completing a CE Housing Assessment does not guarantee housing.

- 1. Have completed the HMIS introductory course unless you received an override. If you were eligible for an override, you should email Helpdesk@allchicago.org.
- 2. Complete this Skilled Assessor Training course.
- 3. Request access to the Coordinated Entry System project in the HMIS training site by emailing Helpdesk@allchicago.org.
- 4. Complete the Fake Client Assignment in the HMIS training site:
 - Access the assignment file in this course*
 - Go to www.chicago.servicept.com/training
 - Log in with the information in the email from the Help Desk
 - Create a client using the profile in the assignment
 - Enter the Fake Client Assessment into the Coordinated Entry Project
