## Data Entry for FY 2022 HMIS Data Standards Update

## August 2021

HMIS and comparable database software vendors will be provided with mapping instructions to map version FY 2020 of the HMIS Data Standards to the newly updated FY 2022 HMIS Data Standards which go into effect on October 1, 2021. Any use of the word "active" below is defined as in an active status in a project (no end date for the client enrollment or the project) in your HMIS as of October 1, 2021.

There are some back-data entry requirements that are straightforward (i.e. collecting V3 data for active SSVF clients) and others that will require additional conversations and planning with the CoC and users (e.g. entering Emergency Housing Voucher referrals in the community's Coordinated Entry System (CES)).

Remember that HMIS Leads, and System Administrators are strongly encouraged to review all updates made based on the vendor mapping. There are vendor mapping instructions for 3.06 Gender, V3 Financial Assistance – SSVF, and V7 HP Targeting Criteria.
